Collaborated on research partnerships with:

- The **Modern Language Association** to document the impact of recruitment, retention, and career readiness projects supported by its Mellon-funded *Pathways* program for underserved students in language, literature, and culture
- The American Council of Learned Societies and the American Academy of Religion to document the landscape of publicly and community-engaged projects focused on exploring the cultural, social, or historical dimensions of religion
- The **Teagle Foundation** to continue a longitudinal study of their *Knowledge for Freedom* program, which supports immersive humanities experiences emphasizing civic engagement for underserved high school students at more than 20 colleges and universities
